Project Management Level I Online

Learn the core strategies, methods, and terminology used in project management. Build practical knowledge of the five stages of the project lifecycle with an emphasis on Initiation and Planning, and gain a clear understanding of the skills and responsibilities required of an effective Project Manager.
